It is always a very enjoyable evening and there will be drinks and a buffet afterwards


Parish Council meeting dates 2015

Headley's new playground is now complete and we hope you are pleased with the new football/basketball goals recently installed. The playground has proved to be immensely popular and is in use every day - even in the winter! We were pleased to learn that many families have held birthday parties in the playground rather than at home - enjoy!!

We had some problems with the original path, as it was a loose surface design and we had two instances of erosion during heavy rain. Playdale were keen to resolve this (at their expense) and we now have a bonded rubber mulch path, which won't suffer the same problems, and is nice and soft to walk on and much safer.

We have received requests for additional seating within the playground - especially around the perimeter, where parents can sit and watch the children having fun. We would like to do this as soon as we can, but no funds are available at the present time...

** Affordable Housing **

During the latter part of last year, Tudors submitted a planning application for the Church Lane nursery site, without discussing the details with the Parish Council. Unfortunately the proposal did not guarantee priority for the Affordable Housing in perpetuity for people with a connection with Headley, so the Parish Council agreed to oppose the application. We were also concerned about the lack of information about plans for the remainder of the site.

As a consequence, Tudors decided to withdraw the application to see how the concerns can be addressed. A further meeting has taken place with the site owners and the planners at Mole Valley DC, and as a result we expect a more acceptable proposal to be prepared in the coming weeks.

If the proposals are acceptable to the Parish Council, we will hold an open day, so that everyone gets the opportunity to view the plans and have their say. We have advised the owners throughout the process that community support is necessary before the Parish Council will approve any plans for the site.

Emergency Plan

We have been working on the preparation of an Emergency Plan, so that in the event of a state of alert situation, we are better prepared to liaise with and look after the welfare of our residents.

We will be talking briefly about the Plan at the Annual Village Meeting on 14th May ◆
